
IMO VDR/SVDR requirements for existing ships Regulation A.861(20)

To assist in casualty investigations, cargo ships, when engaged on international voyages, shall be fitted with a VDR which may be a simplified voyage data recorder (SVDR) as follows:


- ➤ In the case of cargo ships of 20,000 gross tonnage and upwards constructed before 1 July 2002, at the first scheduled dry docking after1 July 2006 but not later than 1 July 2009
- ➤ In the case of cargo ships of 3,000 gross tonnage and upwards but less than 20,000 gross tonnage constructed before 1 July 2002 the first scheduled dry-docking after 1 July 2007 but not later than 1 July 2010




